Without Yelo Leavz, Ooh Sticky, and a good friend overseas, none of this would have been possible. Huge shoutout to our regulars as well, always coming in, catching a vibe, and bringing great energy every weekend. Our lease ends July 1st of this year, so our last operating month will be May, opened each Sunday from 2:00 - 11:00 PM. Our main and first storefront location, GROWF Herbal Bar + Shop, in Downtown Suffolk will also be closing sometime this year. So many dope memories, connections, and relationships are rooted here. From the Controversial Conversation Smoke Sessions, PUFF N MICs, Parkin' Lot Pimpin', and even the dope events you all have thrown, like graduation parties to baby showers to showcases and more, the foundation for our own growth as a company is so fertile and abundant and wouldn't have been possible without you. Thank you. Thank you for spreading the word, thank you for coming out and smoking one, thank you from bringing friends and family, thank you for stocking up on teas and herbs, thank you for the honest feedback, words of advice and encouragement, and most of all thanks for the smiles and the love. It was so wonderful to see and interact with many of you face-to-face and in-person. I have truly learned a lot from this experience and cannot wait to reflect, process, and grow from it. Everything has been happening so fast from the very beginning and its hard to look back while you still driving. But as we all like to say, "we still in this bxtch!".

GROWF Herbal Bar + Shop's lease ends December 1st of this year, however someone can come in and take over our lease at any point between now and then and we would only have 60 days do move out. So, there is no exact date yet, but if we are to continue all the way until the lease is over, the last day of operation will most likely be in late September or mid October. It's my committed goal to continue to run the shop, to the best of my abilities, until the very last day. Now, you're probably wondering why, right? I'm already starting the process, but once both locations are closed, I want you all to know that I am going to be putting my focus towards my physical, mental, financial, and spiritual health. It's important for me to do this as I feel if I am not okay or in the right start of mind, then the business won't be either. I truly hope you all understand.

Online sales will still resume and a rebrand with new product lines are definitely in the plans for the future. I just ask if you could please be patient with me moving forward, as right now it is mainly me by myself handling both stores inventory, online orders, and wholesale orders, with help from friends and family from time to time.

HUGE shout outs and thank you's for those who really made GROWF a possibility. My team was literally the absolute best. I've learned so much about myself and building organic relationships with them that it's definitely been a major part of my personal development as a young adult. Their energy created the vibe in the store and it was always inviting and fun to be there laughing and experiencing this journey together. A bond that I don't believe will be broken.
